Combined Oral Contraceptives (COCs) - Monophasic Low Strength	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ① Gedarel® 20/150 (ethinylestradiol 20micrograms, desogestrel 150micrograms) (21 day preparation) ① Millinette® 20/75 (ethinylestradiol 20micrograms, gestodene 75micrograms) (21 day preparation)
Oral progestogen-only Contraceptives(POPs)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ① Cerelle® (desogestrel 75 microgram) tablets
Contraceptive Devices-Intrauterine Devices	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ① T-Safe® 380A QL ① TT380® Slimline ② Nova-T® 380
Parenteral progestogen-only Contraceptives - Injection	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ① Medroxyprogesterone acetate 150mg/ml (Depo-Provera®)
Parenteral progestogen-only Contraceptives - Implant	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ① Etonogestrel 68mg (Nexplanon®)
Intrauterine progestogen-only Device	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ① Kyleena® 19.5mg intrauterine device ① Mirena® (intrauterine device releasing levonorgestrel 20 micrograms/24 hours)
Emergency contraception	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ① Copper intrauterine device ① Levonorgestrel® 1.5mg tablet (if IUD not available and within 72 hours of UPSI) ① Ulipristal (ellaOne®) 30mg tablets (if IUD not available within 120 hours of UPSI)
Drugs for Voiding (obstructive) Symptoms in Men - Alpha blockers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ① Tamsulosin 400 micrograms M/R capsules ② Alfuzosin 2.5mg tablets; 10mg m/r tablets
Drugs for Voiding (obstructive) Symptoms in Men - 5 alpha-reductase inhibitors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ① Finasteride 5mg tablets

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Drugs for Urinary Frequency, Enuresis and incontinence	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ① Solifenacin 5mg, 10mg tablets ① Tolterodine 1mg, 2mg tablets (immediate release) ① Tolterodine m/r 2mg, 4mg capsules ① Trospium 20mg tablets
Drugs used in Urological Pain	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ① Potassium citrate mixture BP (potassium citrate oral solution containing potassium citrate 30%, citric acid monohydrate 5% in a suitable vehicle with a lemon flavour)
Drugs for Erectile Dysfunction	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ① Sildenafil tablets 25mg, 50mg, 100mg ② Tadalafil 10mg and 20mg tablets
